The Budget Hearing was called to order at 6:40 pm due to technical issues with the audio feed for Jonathan Tiber. The following members were present: Trustees- Jonathan Tiber (via audio feed), Cooper Sherman, and Fiscal Officer- Paula H. Jolly.

Ms. Jolly took roll call for attendance. Mr. Tiber and Mr. Sherman responded here.

The Budget Hearing was advertised as a legal notice for the Claridon Township Budget for the next succeeding fiscal year ending December 31, 2022.

The Fiscal Officer gave an overview of the budget for 2022, including information for the General Fund, Fire and EMS Funds, Gasoline Tax Fund, Road and Bridge Levy Fund, Motor Vehicle License Tax Fund, Cemetery Fund, Zoning Fund, and Permissive Motor Vehicle Tax Fund.

The Board of Trustees were presented with a packet of documents which provided a 5-year overview of all funds and the current proposed Budget for 2022.

Mr. Mike Loza, Claridon Resident, asked questions pertaining to the collection and distribution of property taxes. There were no other comments or questions.


Motion by Mr. Sherman, second by Mr. Tiber to adjourn the meeting.
