

Claridon Township

Mowing and Maintenance Services

April 1, 2017 through November 30, 2017

Contractor shall provide the necessary equipment, materials and labor to perform the following services.

Weekly Mowing and Trimming:

1. Every week, mowing will be performed maintaining a minimum height of two and one-half inches (2 ½") and a maximum of three and one-half inches (3 ½");
2. Trimming of all headstones, lampposts, electrical boxes, gas meters, trees, curbs, signposts, and the like, will also be performed weekly;
3. Excessive grass clippings causing clumps will be blown to break them up;
4. All sidewalks, driveways, parking areas, and headstones will be blown off and made free from grass clippings;
5. Weed Killer shall be used on all fence areas including fence in Claridon Park
6. A weekly inspection of the grounds will be performed, and Claridon will be made aware of any noticeable issues not covered by an agreement for these services;
7. Fallen leaves will be mulched when mowing is performed in the autumn;
8. Beds around the Township Park will kept free of weeds and debris.
9. Mowing and trimming ditches on US 322 and Claridon Troy Rd.

- Town Hall Park / Red Tulip Project House
- Claridon Center/ Maintenance Building
- Claridon Center Cemetery
- East Claridon Cemetery
- Aquilla Road Cemetery
