

**RECORDS OF PROCEEDINGS  
CLARIDON TOWNSHIP  
REGULAR MEETING**

**March 18, 2024**

The regular meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm with the following members present: Trustees- Jonathan Tiber, Cooper Sherman, and Fiscal Officer- Paula J. Hietanen.

Ms. Hietanen took roll call for attendance. Mr. Tiber and Mr. Sherman responded here.

**MARCH 4, 2024 REGULAR MEETING MINUTES- 24-27**

Motion by Mr. Sherman, second by Mr. Tiber to approve regular meeting minutes of 3/4/2024 as written. There was no discussion and a roll call vote was taken.

**GUEST**

Mr. Ted Coblenz and associate, MK Roofing & Construction, were in attendance to present a roof replacement quote for the maintenance building, in the amount of \$24,350.47 (metal roof). Two additional quotes will be obtained from other contractors and will be presented at the next meeting.

Mr. Paul Miller, NOAH- Amish volunteers helping communities of Geauga County, was also in attendance to introduce himself and to discuss the upcoming trash pick-up along the State roads (sides of roads and ditches) of Geauga County. The event will take place on 4/27 and will consist of over 250 Amish volunteers, that plan on covering around 70 miles of State roads. Mr. Miller said that ODOT will be sending 3-4 of their employees to help pick up trash bags (gathered and left in ditches/sides of State Roads), and asked for any other volunteers willing to drive Amish volunteers. Mr. Miller also asked if the trash bags could be picked up the same day, or the following day at the latest, due to sun reflecting off of the plastic bags and scaring Amish horses while on the roads pulling buggies.

Mr. Ted Coblenz offered to send couple of his employees (MK Roofing & Construction) with a large trailer to pick up trash bags.

Chief Geiss, Chardon Fire Department, was also in attendance to discuss the upcoming Fire contract renewal/CFD financial plans for the next 3 years, and to provide the BOT with a list of calls; 2023 total of calls: 2362, 2023 Claridon Twp calls: 272. He also discussed several grants the CFD is applying for, and informed the BOT that their new Ambulance truck just arrived after a 2 year long wait (\$326,000.00 cost).

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**ZONING**

Mr. Alusheff reported that two zoning use violations cases have been turned over to the Prosecutor's Office.

**ROADS**

Mr. Tiber presented the BOT with a crack sealing quote from GT Contracting LLC, for \$40,000.00. The BOT will be requesting more quotes from other contractors to present at one of the future meetings.

**EQUIPMENT**

Mr. Sherman reported that a 36-inch bucket attachment has been purchased and delivered.

Motion by Mr. Sherman, second by Mr. Tiber to adjourn the meeting.


