QUICK CLARIDON HISTORY QUIPS

1953 - Claridon Local School Catches on Fire

On Friday, January 16, 1953 a fire broke out in Claridon Local School. The fire, caused by a burning chimney, was in the walls. The school was evacuated and the fire extinguished. While some classrooms were still usable, the rest of the school was rebuilt and opened in the fall of 1953.

1959 - Geauga Community Hospital Opens

Geauga Community Hospital opened in Claridon Township. Throughout the next 40 years, Geauga Hospital opened two new wings accommodating more than 100 patients and enhanced diagnostic, ancillary, and support services, as well as a critical care unity. 1986 - Earthquake in Claridon

Just before 11:47 a.m. on January 31, 1986, a 4.96 magnitude earthquake, commonly rounded up to 5.0, happened just north of the Geauga-Lake County line, according to the Ohio Department of Natural Resources. The earthquake was felt over a large area including 11 states, parts of Canada and the District of Columbia.
