

**RECORDS OF PROCEEDINGS
CLARIDON TOWNSHIP
SPECIAL MEETING**

May 9, 2022

The Special Meeting/work Session was called to order at 5:30 pm with the following members present: Trustees- Jonathan Tiber, Cooper Sherman, and Roger Miller and Fiscal Officer- Paula H. Jolly.

Ms. Jolly took roll call for attendance. Mr. Tiber, Mr. Sherman and Mr. Miller responded here.

The Special Meeting/work Session was advertised for the purpose of discussing how to navigate the maintenance of township's roads with insufficient funds to do so.

The BOT discussed concern over how to continue the maintenance of township roads with the recent failure of the 1.76 Mill Road levy, again. They discussed that a road levy has not been passed since 1992, and that Claridon Township ranks last for townships in Geauga County in estimated revenue from inside and outside millage. It also ranks last in Revenue collected per resident and second last in revenue collected per mile of township roads.

The BOT decided to pass out flyers during Senior Trash Day and Regular Trash Day outlining the facts pertaining to the Road levy.
