The Special Meeting was advertised for the purpose of adopting a resolution declaring it necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten mill limitation, excluding Aquilla Village.

RESOLUTION DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX IN EXCESS OF THE TEN MILL LIMITATION- 2022-05

Motion by Mr. Sherman, second by Mr. Miller to declare it necessary to levy a tax in excess of the ten-mill limitation for the benefit of Claridon Township, Geauga County, Ohio, excluding Aquilla Village, for the purpose of: general construction, reconstruction, resurfacing and repair of streets, roads and bridges in townships pursuant ORC Section 5705,19 (G). This levy is at a rate not exceeding one and seventy-six hundredths (1.76) mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts to 1.76 cents (\$1.76) for each hundred dollars of valuation, as an additional levy for a 5-year period of time. The tax shall first be levied in tax year 2022 and begin collection in year 2023.


