The regular meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm with the following members present: Trustees- Cooper Sherman, Jonathan Tiber, and Fiscal Officer- Paula J. Hietanen.

OCTOBER 2, 2023 REGULAR MEETING MINUTES- 23-151

GUEST

Assistant Chief Gaspar, Chardon Fire Department, was in attendance to present the BOT with a list of calls and recent happenings within the CFD. He shared that Claridon currently has 218 YTD calls, and 30% of those calls were mutual aide calls. He also shared that the new squad truck is still on order (for 1.5 year), and that the new cot (for the new squad truck) and 48 new hoods and gloves (via grant) have been received. Chardon FD recently hired 2 full time employees, and is currently in process of interviewing 3 candidates for a lieutenant position.

ZONING

Mr. Alusheff presented the BOT with a zoning report/overview of year-to-date zoning permits and their costs. He also spoke about several zoning violations he's been following up on, and a new agricultural exemption application process/form.

Mr. Burzanko presented the BOT with a quote for a new 2024 International CV chassis/snow and ice control equipment package from the Trivista Equipment, for \$172,693.05.

SNOW AND ICE CONTROL AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE GCBC, GCEO AND CLARIDON TOWNSHIP BOT FOR 2023-2024 WINTER SEASON- 2023-17

Motion by Mr. Tiber, second by Mr. Sherman to approve the Snow and Ice Control Agreement between the Geauga County Board of Commissioners, Geauga County Engineer and Claridon Township Board of Trustees; via RRP Program, for the upcoming 2023-2024 Winter Season. The following Township Roads will be covered by this agreement:

Ensign Road (TR-111), Forrest Road (TR-114), Hall Road (TR-109), Spencer Road (TR-345), Stillwell Road (TR-110), Taylor Wells Road (TR-113, and Forest Road (TR-114).

MOTION TO APPROVE THE SHARED PARKING LOT PLOWING AGREEMENT FOR 2023-2024 WINTER SEASON- 23-153

The agreement acknowledges the Township's maintenance crew will plow the shared parking lot between the First Congregational Church and Claridon Admin Building, at no cost to the Church. Plowing will be performed solely at the discretion of the township's maintenance team, and only while the other (Township's) portion of the parking lot is being plowed. The agreement will hold Claridon Township and its employees harmless of any incidents/damage caused by the ice and snow removal. ROLL CALL VOTE:

Ms. Hietanen reported that a letter from the GC Board of Commissioners has been received regarding the upcoming road work (asphalt resurfacing) on Claridon Troy Road (CH-003, Sections D-E) in Burton and Claridon Township.

Mr. Tiber reported that he recently had a conversation with Mr. Beck (Osmond Road) regarding the condition of Osmond Road, and whether the Township plans to pave Claridon's portion of the road. The BOT briefly discussed the need of having a border sign identifying where the Claridon portion of Osmond Road ends, and Burton portion starts.
