

**RECORDS OF PROCEEDINGS
CLARIDON TOWNSHIP
REGULAR MEETING**

August 18, 2025

The regular meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm with the following members present: Trustees- Jonathan Tiber, Cooper Sherman, Roger Miller, and Fiscal Officer- Clint Hardman.

Mr. Hardman took a roll call for attendance. Mr. Tiber, Mr. Sherman and Mr. Miller responded here.

AUGUST 4, 2025 REGULAR MEETING MINUTES- 25-148

Motion by Mr. Tiber, second by Mr. Sherman to approve the regular meeting minutes of 8/4/2025 as written. There was no discussion, and a roll call vote was called.

GUESTS

Chief Davidson, BVFD, was in attendance to present the BOT with a YTD list of calls for Claridon Township; 64 calls YTD, and 15 calls in July.

MAINTENANCE

The BOT was presented with a detailed maintenance report by Mr. Stenger, along with quotes from VanCuren Services for tree trimmings in Aquilla Village, and Ronyak paving quote for chip and seal on Osmond Road, maintenance and Rec Park drives. Quotes will be reevaluated and discussed during the work session scheduled for 9/8/2025.

BUILDINGS

Mr. Tiber reported that members of the ADP will be at the administrative building on 8/20/25 at 11 am to gather information and evaluate all of township's current hardware. (computers, printers, etc.)

EQUIPMENT

Mr. Stenger presented the BOT with a list of necessary equipment/tools that maintenance department would like to purchase in 2026.

ROADS

Mr. Tiber reported that there has been an ongoing overgrown vegetation issue on and near 151 Turner Drive in Aquilla Village. The home owner has been refusing to have the maintenance department remove the overgrown vegetation for traffic/public safety. Mr. Tiber explained that according to ORC Section 5543.14, County Engineer or Township maintenance/road crew (at the discretion of

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the BOT) has the authority to remove any and all trees/shrubs or any other vegetation that is growing in or encroaching onto the right-of-way of the county/township roads. Sheriff's office has been notified and will offer assistance if needed during the clearing of the shrubs on 8/21/25. The home owner will be notified, and also provided with a copy of the ORC pertaining to this matter.

**MOTION TO RECOGNIZE AND GIVE AUTHORITY TO CLARIDON
MAINTENANCE DEPARTMENT CREW TO RESOLVE THE ISSUE OF
OVERGROWN SHRUBS ON AND NEAR 151 TURNER DRIVE- 25-149**

Motion by Mr. Tiber, second by Mr. Miller to recognize and give authority to Claridon Maintenance Department crew to resolve the issue of overgrown shrubs on and near 151 Turner Drive in Aquilla Village, per ORC Section 5543.14. See attached.

Mr. Hardman presented the BOT with a detailed Fiscal Officer report. Mr. Tiber and Mr. Hardman reported that today's Budget Hearing at the Auditor's Office went extremely well.
